

Continuance regulations of the Polytechnic School

(including within the Continuance Regulations of the UdL for bachelor's degrees, approved by the Governing Council of the UdL January 27, 2011)

TITLE 2

CONTINUANCE REGULATIONS OF THE POLYTECHNIC SCHOOL

Article 5. Scope of application

These regulations govern the continuance requirements of bachelor's degrees offered at the Polytechnic School of the University of Lleida.

Article 6. Full-time and part-time students

Part-time students are those who are in paid employment while taking their university studies. All other students shall be considered full-time.

Students wishing to study part time must substantiate their request to do so by providing the documentation specified in the Registration Regulations of the University of Lleida. This documentation must be provided when registering to study part-time.

Part-time students must register for a minimum of 24 credits per academic year. The maximum number of credits that part-time students may register for is the same as that set for full-time students.

Article 7. Continuance for the first year

7.1 Full-time students must pass the first year within a maximum of 2 academic years.

7.2 Part-time students must pass the first year within a maximum of 3 academic years.

Article 8. Continuance for the second, third and fourth years

8.1 Full-time students must pass the second, third and fourth years within a maximum of 7 academic years.

8.2 Part-time students must pass the second, third and fourth years within a maximum of 9 academic years.

Article 9. Continuance by subject

In order to pass each of the second, third and fourth-year subjects, students have the number of academic years as set out in the General Continuance Regulations of the University of Lleida.

Article 10. Change of study mode

10.1 Students may only change from full-time to part-time mode in the official registration period for each year.

10.2 Students may not change mode if one of the deadlines set out in Articles 7 and 8 of these regulations has passed.

10.3 Students who change mode may take the degree's remaining credits in accordance with the provisions set out in Articles 7 and 8 of these regulations.

Article 11. Exclusion from studies

Students who do not meet the requirements set out in Articles 7 and 8 of these regulations must leave the degree for a period of 1 year, after which they may register to take it again, in accordance with the provisions set out in the General Continuance Regulations of the University of Lleida.
